---Treasurer Jerry Zellner stated that as of March, 31 2026 the town has a checking balance of \$2,795.68, Savings of \$137,592.79 and the CD of \$203,107.61 for a total of \$343,496.08. The checking account has been switched over to the Bank of Luxemburg. All checks for the month of March have been written out of the Bank of Luxemburg account. The Nicolet Checking Account has been closed.

There were high water issues with the significant rain events on April 4th and April 14th. The following roads had signs warning of high water or were closed: River Rd-east of AB, River Rd-east of H, Hawthorne & Rockledge, County Line-south of 54, Church Rd-between Countyline & Walhain. New culvert on Luxemburg Rd, will have to be looked at as the rip rap is now washed out by culvert and in the middle of creek. Now the water is running around pile and eroding the sides of creek.
