

March 22, 2023 Town of Luxemburg Meeting

Meeting called to order by the Town Chairman Linda Jonet at 7:00 PM

Order of Business:

Approval of the February Monthly Meeting Minutes after a few minor adjustments - motion made by Leonard Wachal, 2nd by Ken Dart to approve. 2 ayes, 0 nays. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report:

As of 2/28/23 - \$134,163.20 in checking, \$179,881.16 in one Money Market and \$77,368.43 in another Money Market. We received \$4,256.33 for bridge aid this month. 1st Monday in April we will be getting highway aid of \$39,390.10.

Zoning Report:

Edith Lauscher reported the following zoning meetings are set up: March 30 – David & Stacey Jauquet, April 5 – James & Judith Theys, April 11- Jason Rollins and April 17 -John Mleziva. Dale Rollins got a building permit for addition to home - \$75.

New Business:

Supervisors will be riding the roads and checking signs. Will be replacing Church Rd at Rendezvous Rd sign.

Motion to approve Annual Report made by Ken Dart, 2nd by Leonard Wachal to approve. 2 ayes, 0 nays. Motion carried. Bob Weidner asked to receive a copy since it was approved but request was denied. He will be able to get one at the Annual Meeting on April 18, 2023.

Next year we will need to have Baylake do our Comprehensive Plan. This will cost between \$10-\$12K which we will use our ARPA money for. Luxemburg did their Comprehensive Plan and projects that they need an additional 164 acres for residential, 39 acres for commercial and 35 acres for industrial to 2043.

Reminder that HWY 54 from Rockledge Road to Sunset Ave in Algoma will take 50 days and begins Mid-April until late October.

Our new rescue squad is ordered and will be here by the end of next year. Cost is \$266k which is \$100k up from the 2018 price. Our portion will be around \$25k which we will use ARPA money on.

With our ARPA money, we replaced lights inside and out in the Luxemburg Town Hall. We will also check into Focus on Energy to see if there are any rebates.

Next monthly meeting is Wednesday, April 26, 2023.
